

Gramp, Hardy, Hill Smith Prize for Outstanding Wine of Provenance

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SECTION 5 – Class 69 & 70

- Class 69a - Red Wine, current vintage.**
- Class 69b - Red Wine, Between 5 & 9 years older.**
- Class 69c - Red Wine, 10 years or older.**

- Class 70a - White Wine, current vintage.**
- Class 70b - White Wine, Between 5-9 years older.**
- Class 70c - White Wine, 10 years or older.**



Introduced in 2009 to recognise wines that reflect their region, lineage and longevity, the prize is named in honour of three iconic Australian wine industry pioneers – Hugo Gramp, Tom Hardy and Sidney Hill Smith – who perished in October, 1938, in an aircraft accident. The trio were travelling to Canberra for a wine industry conference, when their plane (the Kyeema) crashed into Mount Dandenong, killing all 18 passengers and crew.

The Provenance Prize was judged by 3 of the best; Andrew Callaird MW, Pam Dunsford OAM and Ian MacKenzie. The wines needed to demonstrate superior quality as a group, as well as consistency of style and expression.
