## 4. Finance

4.1 Finance Papers & Update – OJ & BR provided an update and referenced the Finance Reports dated 19 March 2020 (P&L, Aged Receivables, Aged Payables & Balance Sheet) & Meeting TBC & Budget Update. Noted also the Budget that had been prepared and presented to consider impacts of Roadshow. BR noted the need to monitor the situation and transfers to cover costs and the potential for delays with member payments given the climate. Office to work with Treasurer and Finance Committee.



## 4.2 Grants Update - Provided an update as follows.

- Mixed Dozen Project is progressing well. The project was due to complete in April and given COVID-19 on top of the bushfires an extension was provided as the marketing is of no value now. Steering Committee will continue and it is subject to approval that LCLGA Tourism will take over the role to maintain the <a href="www.limestonecoast.org.au">www.limestonecoast.org.au</a> wine trails and that all parties will consider financing contribution. For example Coonawarra Vignerons could contribute for example \$1000 to assist with ongoing operations to ensure long term sustainability for benefit of our 33 brands that can have ATDW listings and develop further bookable experiences to promote. We have incorporated the link onto our website and in our promotional materials due for renewal including the Cellar Dwellers program online. <a href="https://coonawarra.org/event/cellar-dwellers2020/">https://coonawarra.org/event/cellar-dwellers2020/</a>
- SAWIA Project 250 matched up to \$25k funding two invoices submitted and paid. We will now close
  out the final reporting with provision of videos and just working through access to social media
  templates.
- SAWIA Project 250 next round was scheduled to close on 14 April 2020 and PMN: Extended closure to 24 April 2020 – Draft SAWIDS Application to be presented to Board and discussed in next meeting.
- SATC Grant closes 1 May (extended due to COVID-19) OJ working on two applications. 1 to extend
  Cellar Dwellers for visitation \$5k for Hero Wine and Fire Event and seeking Grapes of Mirth assistance
  with additional application circa \$10 -\$15k for promotion of Comedy extension from Friday to
  Sunday, prior to Saturday's Comedy and Wine in Coonawarra and enabling Sunday for Cellar Door
  visitation creating a Comedy & Wine Festival (3 day affair) in conjunction with the Cup on the
  Thursday.
- GWC Seeking inbound knowledge exchange bursary to assist with International Speaker/s for Cabernet Symposium in July/November 2021. PMN: Potential impacts based on COVID-19 and inability to plan until Jan 2021. OJ also raises concern regarding financial ability for wine industry to support conferences so soon after the pandemic.
- Landscape SA (former SENRM Board) potential to apply for funds noting focus on drought resilience
- PIRSA Drought Resilience Potential if Cabernet Symposium has a climate control component.

#### 5. Correspondence & Communication
