- 2021 3500 copies). Event landing page is now live with links to food and wine pages, special events, tastings and "get hands on" categories. Posters will have embedded QR code linking back to the event program on the website. HE to order for distribution before end of May 2021.
- Back Vintage Tasting Hollick Estates Event live with ticket link on coonawarra.org. Hollick will coordinate tickets as they will include a dinner option/s. It is suggested for wineries to showcase 2 back vintage wines, rather than a back vintage and current release comparison. Date confirmed Friday 9th July 5-7pm \$35 Tasting. Event capped at 15 Wineries. HE to send invite to wineries with first in best dressed arrangement due to limited numbers.
- Cellar Dwellers Launch Heidi has liaised with Robe and Grampians Tourism Associations and both indicated the week before June Long weekend wouldn't be ideal for operators. Event to move to following week - Wednesday 16th June. 1pm - 3pm. Given short lead time preference to host event at venue with furniture and heating on hand. Whistle Post previously being considered. Raidis Estate and Brands Laira suggested as alternate options. Committee agree it would be good to host Brand's Laira, with Eric historic cellar to add to Theme. HE to confirm availability with Brands. EB to contact Patrons to seek their involvement. HE to send invites to Visitor Information Centres, Restaurants, Hoteliers, Accommodation providers and local media contacts. Funds for this event to be drawn from Inbound Media Famil allocation ca. \$2500 from budget. Simon – Pipers catering pies @ \$5.50/pie
