- Grant (\$50k) We have been notified we were successful in the Grant but funds unknown as yet. Awaiting formal MR from SATC. Printing to go ahead for brochures, advertising on radio, tv, social media & metro etc.
- Shuttle bus Heidi has confirmed Simon & Kerry are available and willing to provide service. Min. \$2k service fee and \$20 per head fee for passengers to apply. HE has sent email to WRC to request contribution to subsidise the Shuttle bus. No response from WRC. *Action: HE to follow up.*
- GOLF DAY: Friday 1st October Penola Golf Course 9/9.30am start this year.
 \$65 Early bird entry is now closed (\$70 now). Three additional Sponsors, incl BP Nangwarry. 15 currently teams registered. 33 Teams in total, Penola Golf Club Ladies (Rachael Messenger) catering in conjunction with Heidi. There will be a call out to wineries for umbrellas.

- **Roadshow –** 'Cellar Door in the City' Sunday August 29th, National Wine Centre. **POSTPONED.**. Covid room numbers are at 75% but still seated consumption of beverages. Timeframe is too short given the hope restrictions will lift, time to promote the event & to sell tickets. Event to be rescheduled to November. HE liaising with venue.
- Masterclass 9.30-11.30am. Will still go ahead. 70 seats / 17 tickets sold with 10 complimentary. Adelaide Hills Winter Reds is on the same day but shouldn't inhibit numbers. *Action: HE to push promotions*.
- CV CUP 2022 Cup Committee have met with plans to go ahead. Thursday 13th Jan.

8. General Business Maps & Little Black Books (LBB)- Maps are printed. Black books were delayed as waiting on advertiser 8.1 submissions but are still in draft phase. Visitor numbers - HE proposes EOFY figures. 8.2 EB has a copy of the budget. \$7k for Cellar Dwellers - Question \$1500 Misc Expense allocation? 8.3 \$5k – Working w/Journalists. HE / OLR will check on the \$1500 Misc Expense EB suggested to make up packs of local produce for journos as enticement, utilising funds from 20/21 8.4 Journalist/immersion budget. Produce suggested: Wine, Merchandise, Olive Oil, Outback Spices, Honey. Action: EB will compile a list available. Warrnambool Food & Wine event: HE has been approached by Rotary for EOI of Coonawarra wineries to be involved. Held at WBool Race Club (Undercover & grassed areas) & the date proposed is now 15th or 16th Jan 2022 (after CW Cup). Target 2000 people. 8.5 Minimum 10 wineries involved to be eligible as a CVA event but ER recommends a maximum to make it worthwhile to attend. Action: HE will find out more information on consumption/wine sales. Raidis & Koonara attend WBool Night Markets in January but separately.
