### 5. 2021 Events

- Roadshow 'Cellar Door in the City'. Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> November 28 Wineries participated at 2 x 2hr sessions @ \$55/ticket. First session 90-100 people & 2<sup>nd</sup> session 120. Current restrictions were 150 people standing per session, incl winery hosts. Comment made that duration of sessions weren't long enough this year Having less people attending, there was more of a chance to talk longer to Winery reps.
- Masterclass Max 60 available: 30 Tickets 1.30-3pm, (paid tickets @ \$195/ticket) & wine costs are \$3400.

Nick Stock is keen to continue hosting event & his fee is \$1500.

- Achieve Marketing/SA Wine Weekly attended to film the event, taking generic shots venue & event nonspecific. HE negotiated fee to \$500 from \$800.
- ER compiled a mixed wine price list with \$15 freight which was well received! Twelve orders & wine has now been sent. HE made comment that some wines or vintages were varied from original list & also some wines ordered from companies without Coonawarra cellar doors which made fulfilling orders tricky. HE recommends continuing this at events for consumers.
- Event made breakeven status & all refunds & bookings are now neutral for 2022 Roadshow.
- HE has booked a Friday night at National Wine Centre in August, *Action:* HE will let us know the date.
- CV CUP 2022 13<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Tickets have been released with a slow take up from wineries 270 tickets sold– 51 public & 50 sponsors 30 Free (Max 400 available & we need 300 tickets to breakeven). Imperials up for auction have been reduced to eight due to crowd size. DJ Pedro playing tunes. Bus has been organised for Naracoorte (mainly for our 36Deg South sponsors) & MtGambier @ \$15pp. Theme is `cocktail style, smaller marquee & utilizing lawn area. HE will do another Newsletter & FB post.
- LD commented that the Cup Launch was poorly attended by Members & very disappointing for our Sponsors.
- Posters are available for pickup at the office now.
