- Localis HG has written to Adam but he is no longer with Locallis. Heidi would like a report from WRC for
 October statistics to include in SATC report & she will investigate costs of CVA having our own dashboard –
 sub licence to WRC. (WIP)
 - Technology which provides visitation information per geographical location. All council areas are committed to it & the Wattle Range Council have defined the areas of Coonawarra & Penola for statistics. Businesses can request accommodation numbers, how many nights stay, where the visitor resides, etc from WRC.
- ATDW Workshop HG will run an open invite workshop including navigating the CVA website. October calendar now looking too busy & will look at running it later. (WIP)
- WRC Entrance signs: OLR has had 8 x Cab Celebration signs printed in core flout design Two were erected back to back near Greenrise & on Millicent Rd with the rest now stored in the shed for next year. Cost for the 8 signs were \$1000 from funds of \$10k SATC Grant. HG suggests locations being MtG/Millicent & Robe/Penola ends & will seek yearly approval for them all. OLR explained there is a council map of all signs & HG will look into this in the next 6 months, with CD in mind also. BS suggested having a sign at the airport drive. Budget surplus of \$850 Suggestion to use for Cellar Dweller core flout signs perhaps.

• SATC Grants Regional Funding for 3yrs– (WIP) HG & OLR looking into eligibility for 2023 funding.

- EB expressed thanks to HG & OLR for their help in seeing all the events completed. Thanks to KL for her efforts with Golf Day. Thanks to Hollick for Decadence & Wynns for the Masterclass. Well done to all.
- GOLF DAY 2022: Friday 30th September. Members \$270/team Public \$300. 27 teams registered/25 competing on the day. 10 Winery teams 9 Public 8 Sponsor. Raised approx. \$2500 less prizes. EB recommended to liaise with Board on budget expectations etc. HG announced some survey data: Most participants first time, word of mouth. Eleven stayed afterwards Coffee van was well received. No one sat at table placings. Catering was well received & consensus was that the event was well organised. Most teams would participate again. Ideas for 2023 To start earlier & transport from town.

Golf Day 2023 is now online for tickets 29 Sept 2023. Katie to confirm date with Golf Club. Thanks to Steve Raidis for coordinating furniture etc for the day – To confirm a person for 2023.

- Shuttle bus –Mary Cram reported 105 Suttle tickets for the month, over 4 weekends. Online booking system worked well. Mary drove twice with staff doing the rest & after the first weekend, she settled into a routine. Feedback was good & she is willing to put it in her 2023 calendar if she still has buses. Bus phone number was put on wrist bands which was a great idea. \$20 per ticket & WRC sponsored \$3k this year.
- **MtGambier bus** Offered for 3 x weekends. 1st 4 pax (Ocki): 2nd Zero & 3rd 7 pax. Cost \$600 for one weekend. HG keen to include service earlier in promotions & brochure. BS suggested to have QR code to direct patrons to CVA website All the time.
- **Decadence** –**Friday night 14**th **October at Hollick.** Just under 80 tickets to the tasting & 41/43 for dinner with lots of new faces. Ned Goodwin attending w/Sue Hodder & Langtons team. Budget was \$1975 & looking at 2023 venue Parker/Brands??
- Masterclass- Saturday 15th October 10-12pm Global 2019 Cabernet Masterclass. Langtons, Sue Hodder & Master of Wine, Ned Goodwin. Focus on limestone coast soils with 2019 vintage. Tickets \$180 Sold 52 tickets. Event was great! Strong portion of tickets sold to locals Inclusion of Jane Skilton was good Langtons covered cost of wines & Neds accommodation. Jonathan Hesketh & Ox Hardy keen to host event 2023 Venue to be decided. Budget \$2700 & Ocki suggested what remains, to be used as sponsorship for Cup.
- HG received 256 surveys More than 2021 but less than 2020. Heidi will extract data & share at next meeting. Request visitor numbers from Wineries. Regional visitor guide coming out soon CVA advert will include CCC banner. Nearly all brochures were used up. CCC Event Budget \$28k-30k
 CCC 2023 First weekend: Sunday 1st October with five weekends. 13/14/15 Oct Main weekend. School Hols 15/09 x 2 weeks. HG keen to upload website before Roadshow, including QR code & Flyer.
- **SATC** Funds have come in for the next 3 yrs & we received an extra \$10k, making \$30k per year for 3yrs. Second year currently. Funds used to purchase balance of signs.

HG is working on a Marketing Plan to SATC. Heidi suggested to hire another staff member, contracted to CVA to handle the Social Media - Run buses from MtGambier / Naracoorte for CD & CCC events. *Please send any sighted details of CCC events to Heidi as she is putting out media releases to Warrnambool, Bendigo etc.*

Committee suggested ideas for funding: 1) One or two 3x5 Marquees for Golf Day (but discussion on whether they would get used enough?) 2) PA System, 3) Golf Towels, 4) Town Signage, 5) Town banners,6) Photography for wineries & using for marketing material for the CVA, 7) Information Bay on two Coonawarra boundaries 8) Digital content of Coonawarra, 9) Pull up banner 10) Coonawarra sign placed in Bordertown or a printed bill board like is at Nhill & Coleraine – Costs \$4500 & is temporary (3mths).

Group discussion – Six wineries participated in GOM this year & it is stated there must be 30% of Members(10) involved for full CVA promotion. Merrick has done a presentation to SATC for funding & is waiting to hear back. CVA still to hear from Merrick – ER to contact Jason.

OLR reported that we have advertised material for CCC in Qantas Link magazine, Italian & SA Wine magazines. OLR will collate what CVA are involved in. EB has suggested a 'speed dating' style Expo with wineries contacting any desired Journos to attend.
